

TELL US A STORY!

Stories are one of the ways that Aboriginal people have handed down cultural knowledge for thousands of years. In this activity you can make a book and then tell us a story about your kangaroo and joey!

Ingredients needed:

- printer
- 3 (or more) sheets of computer paper
- Kangaroo coloring sheets printed out (as many copies as you need)
- Scissors
- Crayons, colored pencils or markers
- Glue stick

What do I do?

1. Fold your sheets of paper in half the short way, like a hamburger.
2. Cut your papers in half along the fold. (3 sheets will now be 6).



3. Put all your paper in a neat pile. Staple them on the left side to make a book.
4. Print, color and cut out the kangaroo and joey characters.
5. Make the front page your book cover, with a title and your name.
6. Think about the story you want to tell- start arranging your kangaroos on each page of your book.
7. When you are ready, glue your characters onto each page.
8. Don't forget to give them a background!
